ACCESS SERVICE CONCURRENCE

1. General

The rates and charges for the services offered in this tariff are shown hereafter. Rates listed are shown in the same section referenced and in the order that they appear in the Frontier Communications-Midland, Inc. Tariff ILL. C.C. No. 1.

1.1 Access Tariff Concurrence

Access services are those services which are described in the Frontier Communications-Midland, Inc. Tariff ILL. C.C. No 1. These services are offered by the Company to intrastate interexchange customers (ICs) in accordance with the rules and regulations specified in the Frontier Communications-Midland, Inc. Tariff ILL. C.C. No. 1 and approved by the Illinois Commerce Commission, and in any amendments thereto and authorized by the Illinois Commerce Commission or applicable law. The Company does not concur in the rates for access services of Frontier Communications-Midland, Inc.. Rates for these services are set out in the following pages of this concurrence.

1.2 Provision of Services

The Company, to the extent that such services are or can be made available with reasonable effort and after provisions have been made for the Company's telephone exchange services, will provide to an intrastate IC, upon reasonable notice, services of the type offered in the Frontier Communications-Midland, Inc. Tariff ILL. C.C. No. 1 pursuant to the terms and conditions specified therein and at the rates specified in the following pages of this concurrence. The Company's concurrence in the Frontier Communications-Midland, Inc. Tariff ILL. C.C. No. 1 shall not be construed or deemed a representation that all services and service components described therein are available from the Company.

1.3 Cancellation Rights

The Company reserves the right to cancel and make void the above concurrence statement, subject to requirements as may be ordered by the Illinois Commerce Commission, at any and such time as it appears that such cancellation is in the best interest of the Company and/or its customers.
